SALE OF CHAMETZ - 2017

IMPORTANT - PLEASE COMPLETE AND RETURN TO THE SYNAGOGUE OFFICE

In addition to the prohibition of eating Chametz (leaven) on Passover, the Torah requires us to rid our homes of all leaven and leaven products. To accomplish this, we isolate all existing Chametz in secured cabinets and pantries and sell this leaven to a non-Jew prior to Passover. This is a legal sale and conducted in accordance with Jewish and civil law. The Rabbi acts as agent for all consenting families and will repurchase your Chametz at **approximately 8:50 p.m. on Tuesday, April 18.**

Complete the form below and bring it or mail it to the synagogue office, ATTENTION: RABBI ZELL, **no later than Noon Thursday, April 6.** It is customary to include a donation to Tiferet Israel Congregation "**Rabbi's Tzedakah Discretionary Fund**" with your completed form. Funds are used to aid families in need of Passover assistance. Should you know of such a person or family, please contact Rabbi Zell directly. Of course, all such discussions will be strictly confidential.
