SALE OF CHAMETZ

FORM MUST BE RECEIVED BY 5:00PM ON WEDNESDAY, APRIL 13.

During the eight days of Passover, a Jew is forbidden to eat, use or possess (own) Chametz. This Torah prohibition extends to non-food items (example: Play Dough may be Chametz and cosmetics frequently contain Chametz). One who cannot dispose of his/her Chametz before Passover (example: pasta, crackers, etc. in one's pantry, liquors in one's bar, etc.) must authorize his/her Rabbi, in advance, to sell all remaining Chametz to a non-Jew. This transaction (100% legal and binding in both civil and religious laws) must be received in the DK office no later than 5:00PM on Wednesday, April 13th. One must wait one hour after the holiday ends, until 9:30PM on Saturday, April 23rd before using the Chametz sold, as the re-purchase will take an hour to consummate.
